This policy will be achieved by:

- All levels of the Buildtech workers, including PCBU's to be actively involved in consultation and participation
- Compliance with health & safety related legislation, standards codes of practice as a minimum
- Safeguarding workers, visitors and contractors from unnecessary hazards; and where such hazards cannot be eliminated that the risk of likelihood is managed and controlled as much as reasonably possible.
- Timely and accurate reporting and investigation of injury and incidents
- When a worker is injured, Buildtech is committed to the early and safe return to work and where practical, will establish a meaningful rehabilitation programme
- Being committed to continuously improving workplace health & safety to create healthier and safer work environments
- Clearly defining PBSU, Officer and Worker responsibilities and measuring performance against objectives, KPI's and or job descriptions
- Maintaining effective communication at all levels within the organisation and building strong relationships with all stakeholders to the success of health & safety at Buildtech
